You probably know already but just in case you missed it I thought I would bring to your attention the Westminster Government consultation on whether or not to have a badger cull and, if they do decide to have one, how it is going to be carried out.

The idea is that if you kill badgers you stop them giving TB to cattle. The flaw is that if you kill the badgers the cattle will still give TB to other cattle.
