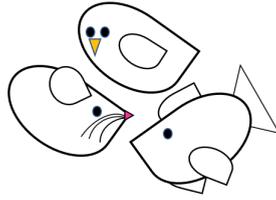

For many years campaigners at Animal Aid have led the fight against the inherent cruelty of horse racing. Tonight at 8.30pm on BBC 1 a Panorama documentary uses undercover footage shot by Animal Aid to expose yet another aspect of the suffering and cruelty caused to equines from thoroughbred racehorses to ponies. No longer of any financial value on the hoof these animals are cruelly liquidated and sold for human consumption. Some of the scenes are not pleasant to watch but please watch if you can.

Why not ask your politicians to watch too? It's repeated this Wednesday and Friday at 3.30am on the BBC News Channel and, for a few days after the 19<sup>th</sup> July, on the BBC iPlayer via the link below. If you know anyone who likes a punt on the horses bet them a quid that they won't be able to watch this all the way through.
