Statement from East Lothian Council on 5th February 2021.

East Lothian Council has confirmed that work to remove feral pigeons roosting in a railway bridge crossing Spott Road, Dunbar will start later this month.

The work, which will be carried out during the day when the bulk of adult pigeons are away from the site, will see the removal of nests and any young pigeons, or squabs, found will be relocated by an animal welfare charity.

Netting to stop future roosting in the bridge will be installed which will include one-way exits to allow any remaining birds to safely leave.

A number of checks will be carried out over the following days to make sure no birds are caught following the works.

In carrying out this work no pigeons will be culled and I am grateful to external agencies including [REDACTED] for taking the time to fully understand the scale of the problem and the proposed solution which will be widely welcomed by people in Dunbar.”
